

Preschool Routine of the day

8-9.30 Children arrive welcomed by keypersons

9.30-10.20 Roll-on snack and freeflow with garden doors open

10.30 Welcome time in keyperson groups. Singing, movement, action songs, games.

11.00 Freeflow to include nappy changing (by key person)

11.45 Lunch. First sitting sleepers, second sitting lunch box, third sitting Little Tums

12.30 Freeflow into garden and nappy change (by key person)

2.15 Tidy up time, snack time in key groups followed by pre planned activities in ability groups covering the 7 areas of learning

4.10 Tidy up time and nappy change

4.15 Liquid refreshment, choice of group for story time

4.30 Toast and tea

4.45-5.30 Freeflow / pick up time

NB:

Freeflow: Children independently travel from room to room and out into the garden enjoying the learning environment. Every week the learning environment is resourced differently in line with the interests of the children that have been documented during individual observations. Staff are very aware of the characteristics of effective learning that include

Exploration and Discovery,

Active learning and

Critical thinking.
